

## CONGRATULATIONS on purchasing your new Liveboard!

To activate your Liveboard on a PC, follow these instructions:

### 1 PLUG IN BLUETOOTH USB ADAPTER

Plug in the included Bluetooth USB Adapter into an available USB drive.

Windows XP and Vista PC's will automatically recognize the device and a Bluetooth icon will appear in your system tray.

After the Adapter is recognized and the Bluetooth Icon appears in your system tray, right-click the icon and select "OPEN BLUETOOTH SETTINGS". Then click the "OPTIONS" tab and make sure the "TURN DISCOVERY ON" box is CHECKED.

### 2 TURN ON THE LIVEBOARD & SET UP FOR WIRELESS CONNECTION

Plug your Liveboard into an available wall outlet within 2-3 feet of your PC and turn the Liveboard on (HI or LO) by the switch on the rear panel.

The rear STATUS LED (RED) will turn on and the WIRELESS LED (BLUE) will go into FAST BLINK mode (*blinking about 4 times/second*) which means your Liveboard is ready to be paired to your PC.

If the WIRELESS LED is in SLOW BLINK mode (*blinking once per second*), press the CONNECT button with a pencil and hold for 3 seconds. This will switch the WIRELESS LED into FAST BLINK mode.

### 3 ADD NEW BLUETOOTH DEVICE

Once your Liveboard's WIRELESS LED (BLUE) is in FAST BLINK mode, right click on the Bluetooth icon in your system tray and select "ADD NEW BLUETOOTH DEVICE".

*(This can also be done through your computer's Control Panel>Network Connections)*

Check the box "My device is set up and ready to be found"

Once the Bluetooth Adapter recognizes the Vroop Liveboard, click on the Vroop Liveboard icon and then click "NEXT"

### 4 PAIR THE LIVEBOARD TO YOUR COMPUTER

Pair the Liveboard to your PC by selecting "Use the passkey found in the documentation" and entering the code: **1234**.

Then Click "Next"

*You may need to attempt this pairing step a few times before the Liveboard begins to communicate with your PC.*

### 5 INSTALL THE LIVEBOARD MANAGER

Download the PC version of *Liveboard Manager* at [www.myliveboard.com/support.htm](http://www.myliveboard.com/support.htm)

After the download, launch the **LiveboardManager.EXE** file and follow installation instructions.

*Once the Liveboard Manager is installed, you'll see a gray baseball icon appear in your system tray. The baseball will turn white with red stitching when the Liveboard is successfully connected to your PC.*
